

TERM LAWYER



Legal Aid Saskatchewan has term job share (.5 FTE) lawyer position available in its Saskatoon City Criminal Legal Aid Area Office for a nine-month term. The rotation is 2 months on and then 2 months off, commencing April 1, 2010 through April 30, 2010, then July 1, 2010 through August 31, 2010 and November 1, 2010 through December 31, 2010.

Legal Aid Saskatchewan, through its 15 offices around the province, provides legal services to persons and organizations for criminal and civil matters where those persons and organizations are financially unable to secure these services from their own resources.

Under the direction of the Legal Director, this individual can expect to practise in the areas of adult and youth criminal law.

Applicants should be Lawyers entitled to practice in Saskatchewan with experience in litigation or general practice of law, preferably in criminal law with experience at Provincial and Queen's Bench Courts. The salary range is \$68,637 to \$122,592 per annum. The incumbents are entitled to 3 weeks annual vacation, 15 EDO's and 13 Statutory Holidays per full fiscal year. Salary and above benefits will be prorated based on part time hours.

This is an opportunity for people who see the practice of law as more than just a job. This is an opportunity to help people who really need it, every day, and to hone your legal skills while doing so.
