Legal Analyst

The Pensions Division protects accrued pension entitlements from undue loss and ensures the equitable treatment of pension plan members.

The Pensions Division is seeking a Legal Analyst, who will provide analytical, research and advisory services on legal, policy and regulatory issues associated with the regulation of pension plans in Saskatchewan. You will assist in the development and implementation of legislation and policy and provide advice to staff on the interpretation of legislation and pension plan contracts. You will also provide advice on complaint handling and enforcement actions.

To qualify for this position, you must have a university degree in law and membership in, or qualification for membership in the **Law Society of Saskatchewan**. You will have comprehensive knowledge of contract law, corporate law and administrative law principles, along with experience in providing formal legal opinions concerning statutory interpretation. Ideally, you will have knowledge of pension law and current issues surrounding pension plans, as well as knowledge of public policy formulation.
