Under the direction of the Legal Director, this individual can expect to practice in the areas of adult and youth criminal law. This position involves some travel in small aircraft to northern communities.

Applicants should be Lawyers entitled to practice in Saskatchewan with experience in litigation or general practice of law, preferably in criminal law including experience at Provincial and Queen's Bench Courts, with experience in family law an asset. The salary range is \$68,637 to \$122,592 per annum. The incumbents are entitled to 3 weeks annual vacation, 15 EDO's and 13 Statutory Holidays per full fiscal year.
