You will represent the staff of the Securities Division before the Commission and the courts.

To qualify for this position, you must have a university degree in law and membership in, or qualification for membership in, the **Law Society of Saskatchewan**. You will have experience in conducting civil litigation, proceedings before administrative tribunals or criminal prosecutions. You will also have comprehensive knowledge of contract law, corporate law and administrative law principles, along with experience in providing formal legal opinions concerning statutory interpretation.

To qualify for this position, you must possess the following:

- a university degree in law and membership in or qualification for membership in the Law Society of Saskatchewan;
- experience in conducting civil litigation, proceedings before administrative tribunals or criminal prosecutions.
