Formal Complaint

I, DONNA SIGMETH, of the City of Regina, in the Province of Saskatchewan, Complaints Counsel for the Law Society of Saskatchewan, do hereby certify that John Will, Vice-Chair of the Discipline Committee of the Benchers of The Law Society of Saskatchewan, has appointed a Hearing Committee pursuant to Section 47(1) of *The Legal Profession Act, 1990*, comprised of Peter Hryhorchuk as Chair, Dawn McBride and Karen Topolinski to hear and determine a formal complaint set out by the Investigation Committee consisting of William H. Holliday and Gregory Walen Q.C., pursuant to Section 46(1) of *The Legal Profession Act, 1990*, against Albert Angus, a lawyer and a member of The Law Society of Saskatchewan, carrying on the practice of law at all of the relevant times in the Province of Saskatchewan, as follows:

THAT Albert Angus, of the City of Saskatoon, in the Province of Saskatchewan is guilty of conduct unbecoming a lawyer in that:

1. He did misappropriate funds from his client, Client X, by rendering an account and receiving funds from that client's trust balance in relation to services for which he had already been paid;

2. He did prepare, or cause to be prepared, a false account which contained entries for which he had already been paid;

Reference Chapters I and XI of the *Code of Professional Conduct*.

3. He did render an account to his client, Client X, and received money from that client's trust balance in relation to time or expenditures associated with his firm's trust reporting obligations to the Law Society of Saskatchewan;

Reference Chapters I and XI of the *Code of Professional Conduct*.

4. He did render an account to his client, Client X, and received money from that client's trust balance in relation to his own personal legal expenses;

Reference Chapters I and XI of the *Code of Professional Conduct*.

5. He did misappropriate funds from his client, Client X, by paying or transferring \$1,600.00 to himself or his firm without authorization to do so;

Reference Chapters I and XI of the *Code of Professional Conduct*.

6. He did misappropriate funds from his client, Client X, by paying or transferring \$4,800.00 to himself or his firm without authorization to do so;

Reference Chapters I and XI of the *Code of Professional Conduct*.

7. He did misapply funds from his client, Client X, by paying or transferring \$8,000.00 to K.B. without authorization to do so;

Reference Chapter I of the *Code of Professional Conduct*.

8. He did breach a written undertaking that he provided to the Law Society of Saskatchewan on June 30, 2005;

Reference Chapter XVI of the *Code of Professional Conduct*.

9. He did fail to respond substantively or at all to various enquiries from the Law Society of Saskatchewan.

Reference Chapter XV of the *Code of Professional Conduct*.
