Formal Complaint


I, DONNA SIGMETH, of the City of Regina, in the Province of Saskatchewan, Complaints Counsel for the Law Society of Saskatchewan, do hereby certify that John Will, Vice-Chair of the Discipline Committee of the Benchers of The Law Society of Saskatchewan, has appointed a Hearing Committee pursuant to Section 47(1) of *The Legal Profession Act, 1990*, comprised of Karen Topolinski as Chair, Victor Dietz, Q.C. and Karen Jones to hear and determine a formal complaint set out by the Investigation Committee consisting of Evert Van Olst and William Holliday, pursuant to Section 46(1) of *The Legal Profession Act, 1990*, against Tara Dionne Chornoby, a lawyer and a member of The Law Society of Saskatchewan, carrying on the practice of law at all of the relevant times in the City of Saskatoon, in the Province of Saskatchewan, as follows:

THAT TARA DIONNE CHORNOBY, of the City of Saskatoon, in the Province of Saskatchewan:

1. Is guilty of conduct unbecoming a lawyer in that she, while employed as an associate at Rask and Company, misappropriated funds from her firm when she received payments from clients and then failed to provide those funds to the firm;

2. Is guilty of conduct unbecoming a lawyer in that she collected GST and PST in relation to legal fees paid to her and failed to remit said GST and PST to the Federal and Provincial governments as required by law.
