



NOTICE OF INTERIM SUSPENSION

TAKE NOTICE THAT GARRET OLEDZKI of Regina, Saskatchewan has been interim suspended as of August 15, 2008 and is no longer entitled to practice law until further notice.

The Law Society of Saskatchewan has reasonable grounds to believe that Garret Oledzki may be guilty of conduct unbecoming a lawyer in that he:

- Imitated the signature of his client on a document purporting to be a Last Will and Testament of his client using the name of his client when he was not in the presence of that client or any witnesses;
- Persuaded a member of the public to sign as a witness on a document purporting to be a Last Will and Testament of his client when he knew she had not witnessed the signing of the document;
- Misled fellow members of the Law Society of Saskatchewan;
- Contrary to Chapter VI of the Code of Professional Conduct, prepared or caused to be prepared documents wherein his clients were to leave or transfer to him or his family members substantial gifts.
