## Amended Formal Complaint

I, DONNA SIGMETH, of the City of Regina, in the Province of Saskatchewan, Complaints Counsel for the Law Society of Saskatchewan, do hereby certify that Greg Walen, Q.C., Vice-Chair of the Discipline Committee of the Benchers of The Law Society of Saskatchewan, has appointed a Hearing Committee pursuant to Section 47(1) of *The Legal Profession Act, 1990*, comprised of Evert Van Olst as Chair and Laura Lacoursiere to hear and determine a formal complaint set out by the Investigation Committee consisting of George Patterson and Miguel Martinez, pursuant to Section 46(1) of *The Legal Profession Act, 1990*, against Russell Milton Peet, a lawyer and a member of The Law Society of Saskatchewan, carrying on the practice of law at all of the relevant times in the Town of Preeceville, in the Province of Saskatchewan, as follows:

THAT Russell Milton Peet, of the Town of Preeceville, in the Province of Saskatchewan is guilty of conduct unbecoming a lawyer in that he:

1. failed to reply promptly to communications from the Law Society of Saskatchewan with respect to complaints by D.D. and M.B.;

2. failed to serve his clients, D.D. and the Estate of O.N., in a conscientious, diligent and efficient manner as follows:


- a. Failed to provide prompt service to D.D. and the Estate of O.N.;
