Formal Complaint


I, DONNA SIGMETH, of the City of Regina, in the Province of Saskatchewan, Complaints Counsel for the Law Society of Saskatchewan, do hereby certify that Reginald Watson Q.C., Vice-Chair of the Discipline Committee of the Benchers of the Law Society of Saskatchewan, has appointed a Hearing Committee pursuant to Section 47(1) of *The Legal Profession Act, 1990*, comprised of BETH BILSON, Q.C., as Chair along with LAURA LACOURSIERE and ERIC NEUFELD, Q.C. to hear and determine a formal complaint set out by the Investigation Committee consisting of William Holliday, pursuant to Section 46(1) of *The Legal Profession Act, 1990*, against MICHELLE LECLAIR-HARDING, a lawyer and a member of The Law Society of Saskatchewan, carrying on the practice of law at all of the relevant times in the City of Saskatoon, in the Province of Saskatchewan, as follows:

THAT MICHELLE LECLAIR-HARDING, of the City of Saskatoon, in the Province of Saskatchewan is guilty of conduct unbecoming a lawyer in that she:

1. Did fail to respond promptly to communications from the Alberta Provincial Court pertaining to the D.M. matter;
2. Did fail to respond promptly to communications from the Law Society of Saskatchewan in relation to the complaint of the Alberta Provincial Court;

3. Did fail to respond promptly to communications from the Law Society of Saskatchewan in relation to the complaint of S.S.;
4. Did fail to maintain effective office systems to ensure receipt of correspondence and/or phone messages.
