## Formal Complaint

I, MELANIE HODGES NEUFELD, of the City of Regina, in the Province of Saskatchewan, Complaints Counsel for the Law Society of Saskatchewan, do hereby certify that Paul Korpan Q.C., Chair of the Discipline Committee of the Benchers of The Law Society of Saskatchewan, has appointed a Hearing Committee pursuant to Section 47(1) of *The Legal Profession Act, 1990*, comprised of Ronald Kruzeniski, Q.C., as Chair, Reginald Watson, Q.C., and Peggy Schmeiser to hear and determine a formal complaint set out by the Investigation Committee consisting of Peter Hryhorchuk, pursuant to Section 46(1) of *The Legal Profession Act, 1990*, against Krishan Kumar, a lawyer and a member of The Law Society of Saskatchewan, carrying on the practice of law at all of the relevant times in the City of Nepean, in the Province of Ontario, as follows:

THAT Krishan Kumar, of the City of Nepean, in the Province of Ontario is guilty of conduct unbecoming a lawyer in that he:

1. did provide false or misleading information to the Law Society of Saskatchewan in his February 15, 2002 Application for Admission as follows:
  - a. he failed to use his proper or legal name on the application;
  - b. he failed to disclose his change of name to "Paul White"; and
  - c. he failed to disclose prior disciplinary actions against him as Paul White in Washington State.


2. did provide false or misleading information to the Law Society of Saskatchewan in his August 18, 2003 Commencement Report by failing to disclose his membership in the Washington State Bar;
