
I, DONNA SIGMETH, of the City of Regina, in the Province of Saskatchewan, Complaints Counsel for the Law Society of Saskatchewan, do hereby certify that ROBERT HEINRICHS, Vice-Chair of the Discipline Committee of the Benchers of The Law Society of Saskatchewan, has appointed a Hearing Committee pursuant to Section 47(1) of *The Legal Profession Act, 1990*, comprised of JOEL HESJE, Q.C. as Chair, GREG STEVENS and DAVID BRUNDIGE to hear and determine a formal complaint set out by the Investigation Committee consisting of GEORGE PATTERSON and DELLA STUMBORG, pursuant to Section 46(1) of *The Legal Profession Act, 1990*, against WILLIAM ROYDEN HOWE, a lawyer and a member of The Law Society of Saskatchewan, carrying on the practice of law at all of the relevant times in the City of Regina, in the Province of Saskatchewan, as follows:

THAT WILLIAM ROYDEN HOWE, of the City of Regina, in the Province of Saskatchewan is guilty of conduct unbecoming a lawyer in that he:

1. Did through his associate, 599875 Saskatchewan Ltd., enter into or continue a debtor-creditor relationship with his clients, Mr. and Mrs. S., that included the preparation of an instrument wherein Mr. and Mrs. S. transferred an interest in

land on certain terms to 599875 Saskatchewan Ltd., without ensuring that Mr. and Mrs. S. received independent legal advice.
