Formal Complaint


I, JODY MARTIN, of the City of Regina, in the Province of Saskatchewan, Complaints Counsel for the Law Society of Saskatchewan, do hereby certify that Miguel Martinez, Vice-Chair of the Discipline Committee of the Benchers of The Law Society of Saskatchewan, has appointed a Hearing Committee pursuant to Section 47(1) of *The Legal Profession Act, 1990*, comprised of GREG STEVENS as Chair, GEORGE COMBE and SANJEEV ANAND to hear and determine a formal complaint set out by the Investigation Committee consisting of MICHAEL MEGAW, Q.C. and DELLA STUMBORG, pursuant to Section 46(1) of *The Legal Profession Act, 1990*, against JOHN DAVID HARDY, a lawyer and a member of The Law Society of Saskatchewan, carrying on the practice of law at all of the relevant times in the City of Saskatoon, in the Province of Saskatchewan, as follows:

THAT JOHN DAVID HARDY, of the City of Saskatoon, in the Province of Saskatchewan is guilty of conduct unbecoming a lawyer in that he:

1. Did fail to serve his client, B.R. in a conscientious, diligent and efficient manner;
2. Did fail to respond to communications from his client B.R. within a reasonable time;

3. Did fail to respond promptly to communications from the Law Society of Saskatchewan in relation to the complaint of B.R.;
4. Did fail to serve his client, G.W. in a conscientious, diligent and efficient manner;
5. Did fail to respond to communications from his client G.W. within a reasonable time; and
6. Did fail to respond promptly to communications from the Law Society of Saskatchewan in relation to the complaint of G.W.
