
Formal Complaint

I, DONNA SIGMETH, Q.C., of the City of Regina, in the Province of Saskatchewan, Complaints Counsel for the Law Society of Saskatchewan, do hereby certify that SANJEEV ANAND, Chair of the Discipline Committee of the Benchers of The Law Society of Saskatchewan, has appointed a Hearing Committee pursuant to Section 47(1) of *The Legal Profession Act, 1990*, comprised of PAUL KORPAN, Q.C. as Chair, MIGUEL MARTINEZ and LORNE MYSKO to hear and determine a formal complaint set out by the Investigation Committee consisting of STEPHEN ORLOWSKI and LORELEY BERRA, pursuant to Section 46(1) of *The Legal Profession Act, 1990*, against DALE NORMAN BLENNER-HASSETT, a lawyer and a member of The Law Society of Saskatchewan, carrying on the practice of law at all of the relevant times in the City of Prince Albert, in the Province of Saskatchewan, as follows:

THAT DALE NORMAN BLENNER-HASSETT, of the City of Prince Albert, in the Province of Saskatchewan is guilty of conduct unbecoming a lawyer in that he:

1. Did in the course of his practice write letters to another lawyer, namely J.M., which were abusive, offensive and otherwise inconsistent with the proper tone of a professional communication from a lawyer;
2. Did offer to forgo civil defamation proceedings against L.B. in exchange for L.B. withdrawing a complaint she had made to the Law Society of Saskatchewan.
