Formal Complaint


I, JODY MARTIN, of the City of Regina, in the Province of Saskatchewan, Complaints Counsel for the Law Society of Saskatchewan, do hereby certify that ROBERT HEINRICHS, Vice-Chair of the Discipline Committee of the Benchers of The Law Society of Saskatchewan, has appointed a Hearing Committee pursuant to Section 47(1) of *The Legal Profession Act, 1990*, comprised of MIGUEL MARTINEZ as Chair, THOMAS HEALEY and GEORGE COMBE to hear and determine a formal complaint set out by the Investigation Committee consisting of JOHN WILL and JOEL HESJE, Q.C., pursuant to Section 46(1) of *The Legal Profession Act, 1990*, against DOROTHY JANE OLSON, a lawyer and a member of The Law Society of Saskatchewan, carrying on the practice of law at all of the relevant times in the City of Saskatoon, in the Province of Saskatchewan, as follows:

THAT DOROTHY JANE OLSON, of the City of Saskatoon, in the Province of Saskatchewan is guilty of conduct unbecoming a lawyer in that she:

1. Did provide false or misleading declarations to the Law Society of Saskatchewan in her annual TA-6 Trust Accounting form for the years 2004 through 2009 by stating that she did not receive or handle money or negotiable valuables in trust, when the opposite was true.

2. Did between 2003 and 2010 fail to deposit monies received or held in trust by her for or on account of her clients into a mixed or separate trust account, contrary to Rule 910;
3. Did fail to comply with Law Society of Saskatchewan Rules 911 and 942 regulating the way in which moneys received or held in trust by her for or on account of clients are to be handled; and
4. Did fail to pay to the Law Foundation, or failed to cause to be paid to the Law Foundation, interest earned on monies received or held in trust by her for or on account of clients as required by *The Legal Profession Act* and the *Rules of the Law Society of Saskatchewan*.
