Formal Complaint


I, DONNA SIGMETH, of the City of Regina, in the Province of Saskatchewan, Complaints Counsel for the Law Society of Saskatchewan, do hereby certify that ROBERT HEINRICHS, Vice-Chair of the Discipline Committee of the Benchers of The Law Society of Saskatchewan, has appointed a Hearing Committee pursuant to Section 47(1) of *The Legal Profession Act, 1990*, comprised of REGINALD WATSON, Q.C. as Chair, GREGORY WALLEN, Q.C. and DAVID BRUNDIGE to hear and determine a formal complaint set out by the Investigation Committee consisting of RICHARD W. DANYLIUK, Q.C. and GREG STEVENS, pursuant to Section 46(1) of *The Legal Profession Act, 1990*, against BRENDA ANNE WALPER-BOSSENCE, a lawyer and a member of The Law Society of Saskatchewan, carrying on the practice of law at all of the relevant times in the City of Moose Jaw, in the Province of Saskatchewan, as follows:

THAT BRENDA ANNE WALPER-BOSSENCE, of the City of Moose Jaw, in the Province of Saskatchewan is guilty of conduct unbecoming a lawyer in that she:

1. Did fail to serve her client, K.R. in a conscientious, diligent and efficient manner, by failing to act on the instructions of K.R. within a reasonable time;

2. Is guilty of conduct unbecoming a lawyer in that she failed to serve her client, M., in a conscientious, diligent and efficient manner, by failing to, within a reasonable time, complete the tasks necessary to effect a transfer of property to D.K.
