**IN THE MATTER OF *THE LEGAL PROFESSION ACT, 1990*
AND IN THE MATTER OF BRENDA ANNE WALPER-BOSSENCE,
A LAWYER OF MOOSE JAW, SASKATCHEWAN**

ORDER

The Hearing Committee of the Law Society of Saskatchewan (hereinafter called the "Hearing Committee") comprised of Reginald Watson Q.C. as Chair, Gregory Walen Q.C. and David Brundige Q.C., having convened on Wednesday, July 6, 2011, determined that BRENDA ANNE WALPER-BOSSENCE is guilty of conduct unbecoming a lawyer, in that she:

- 1. Did fail to serve her client, K.R. in a conscientious, diligent and efficient manner, by failing to act on the instructions of K.R. within a reasonable time; and**
- 2. Is guilty of conduct unbecoming a lawyer in that she failed to serve her client, M., in a conscientious, diligent and efficient manner, by failing to, within a reasonable time, complete the tasks necessary to effect a transfer of property to D.K.**

After due deliberation to determine the action to be taken, the Hearing Committee orders that:

1. Brenda Anne Walper-Bossence shall receive a reprimand;
2. Brenda Anne Walper-Bossence shall, on or before July 29, 2011, pay a fine to the Law Society of Saskatchewan in the amount of \$1,000.00;
3. Brenda Anne Walper-Bossence shall, on or before July 29, 2011, pay costs of these proceedings to the Law Society of Saskatchewan in the amount of \$250.00.
