Formal Complaint

I, VALERIE PAYNE, of the City of Regina, in the Province of Saskatchewan, Complaints Counsel for the Law Society of Saskatchewan, do hereby certify that Brenda Hildebrandt, Q.C., Chair of the Discipline Committee of the Benchers of the Law Society of Saskatchewan, has appointed a Hearing Committee pursuant to Section 47(1) of *The Legal Profession Act, 1990*, comprised of Sean Sinclair, as Chair, Della Stumborg and Nikki Rudachyk to hear and determine a Formal Complaint set out by the Conduct Investigation Committee consisting of Leslie Belloc-Pinder and Ian Wagner, pursuant to Section 46(1) of *The Legal Profession Act, 1990*, against Anderson James Stodalca, a lawyer and a member of the Law Society of Saskatchewan, carrying on the practice of law at all of the relevant times in the City of Regina, in the Province of Saskatchewan, as follows:

THAT ANDERSON JAMES STODALKA, of the City of Regina, in the Province of Saskatchewan is guilty of conduct unbecoming a lawyer in that he:

1. failed to exercise due diligence in responding to his client, C.B., and as such, made representations to C.B. which were not accurate; and
2. failed to exercise due diligence by ensuring that his client, C.B., had properly reviewed and agreed to the terms of a consent order that he had issued by the Court of Queen's Bench.
