

# Expression of Interest - Counsel for Children program

The Office of the Public Guardian and Trustee invites applications from persons with a law degree and an interest in child and family service law to join the roster of lawyers for the Counsel for Children program. We require lawyers located throughout the province.

From our roster of lawyers, legal counsel is appointed pursuant to The Public Guardian and Trustee Act to provide legal representation to children throughout Saskatchewan who are the subject of an application pursuant to The Child and Family Services Act.

A lawyer who would like to be considered to be appointed to the roster of lawyers will be expected to:

- (i) be in good standing with the Law Society of Saskatchewan;
- (ii) provide legal representation in accordance with the Counsel for Children standards; and
- (iii) complete the Counsel for Children training to represent children and youth in child protection proceedings available through Law Society of Saskatchewan webinar materials as well as participate in ongoing conference calls or training.

Our roster of lawyers is paid hourly rates plus disbursements in accordance with the tariff of fees set for the Counsel for Children.
