I, STACEY MCPEEK, of the City of Regina, in the Province of Saskatchewan, Complaints Counsel for the Law Society of Saskatchewan, do hereby certify that Brenda Hildebrandt, Q.C., Chair of the Discipline Committee of the Benchers of the Law Society of Saskatchewan, has appointed a Hearing Committee pursuant to Section 47(1) of *The Legal Profession Act, 1990*, comprised of Scott Moffat, as Chair, Craig Zawada, Q.C. and David Flett to hear and determine a Formal Complaint set out by the Conduct Investigation Committee consisting of Glenn Hepp and Foluke Laosebikan, pursuant to Section 46(1) of *The Legal Profession Act, 1990*, against **Delbert Dynna**, a lawyer and a member of the Law Society of Saskatchewan, carrying on the practice of law at all of the relevant times in the City of Prince Albert, in the Province of Saskatchewan, as follows:

THAT DELBERT DYNNA, of the City of Prince Albert, in the Province of Saskatchewan is guilty of conduct unbecoming a lawyer in that he:

1. did act or continue to act in a manner where there was, or was likely to be, a conflict of interest between his client S.C. and his former client J.L. after the breakdown of a joint retainer.
