

**Senior Justices of the Peace - Regulatory Trials
Saskatoon and Regina**

The Office of the Supervising Justice of the Peace is seeking lawyers who are interested in part-time adjudication work as Senior Justices of the Peace with the Provincial Court of Saskatchewan. There are two part time positions available in Saskatoon and one part time position available in Regina.

Under the direction of the Supervising Justice of the Peace, the successful candidates will be responsible for presiding over regulatory trials involving a variety of provincial statutes and municipal bylaws.

The qualifications required for the position are as follows:

- (1) Law degree with a minimum of five years experience as a practicing lawyer
- (2) Knowledge of criminal procedure
- (3) Superior analytical and conceptual skills
- (4) Excellent communication skills
- (5) Demonstrated ability to make sound and timely decisions
- (6) Demonstrated ability to prioritize workload and work independently
- (7) Ability to interact professionally and respectfully with a wide range of individuals
- (8) Ability to handle confidential information with discretion

Appointments to this position are by Order-in-Council subject to approval by the Lieutenant Governor in Council. Qualified candidates must be eligible for appointment as a Justice of the Peace for the Province of Saskatchewan and must have a non -practicing status with the Law Society of Saskatchewan or be prepared to move to that status upon request.
