Legal Aid Saskatchewan provides accessible and professional legal services in criminal and family law to eligible people.

The following lawyer opportunities are available at the noted locations:

- Northern [La Ronge] - Permanent Position
- Meadow Lake - Term position April through September 2019
- Prince Albert - Term position until approximately mid-July 2019
- Swift Current - Term position for one year*

* The position in Swift Current will include the provision of child apprehension legal advice to clients via telephone; assembling a collection of precedents/briefs used throughout Legal Aid; and completing file assessments.

The lawyers will practice in the areas of adult and youth criminal and family law. The Northern, Meadow Lake and Prince Albert positions involve travel in small aircrafts to northern communities.

Applicants should be Lawyers entitled to practice in Saskatchewan with experience in litigation in both Provincial and Superior Courts. Placement within the salary range [\$77,420 to \$139,708] is commensurate with experience. The positions are within the Union. The permanent position in La Ronge, has a comprehensive benefits package inclusive of Northern Allowance, pension, disability, life insurance/health/dental benefits and Health Care Spending Account. Term employees qualify after 6 months for life insurance/health/dental benefits. On an annual basis, 3 weeks of vacation and 15 EDOs are available (prorated if employed less than a year).

We encourage applications from people of Aboriginal ancestry, persons of a visible minority group, persons with disabilities and women seeking management and non-traditional roles. Legal Aid Saskatchewan has an employment equity program approved by the Saskatchewan Human Rights Commission.
