

The College of Physicians and Surgeons is looking to hire a junior or mid-career lawyer. This is a salaried position with generous benefits, including a pension plan.

The successful candidate will work with Bryan Salte and Sheila Torrance at the College. We expect that the primary focus of the lawyer will be to work in the discipline department of the College addressing complaints that physicians have engaged in unprofessional conduct. It is likely to include overseeing the investigation of such complaints and, if a charge of unprofessional conduct is laid, prosecuting the charge before the discipline committee in contested matters. However, the successful candidate should be prepared to provide legal services in all aspects of the work of the College which includes general counsel work, assisting in policy development, etc.

We expect that the successful candidate will have litigation experience, including acting as counsel in trials or administrative hearings. The position may be ideal for a lawyer with 5 to 10 years of experience as a prosecutor. However, all applications will be considered.

The legal work of the College focuses on professional regulation, including discipline investigations, discipline hearings and dealing with court applications, but involves work in a very broad range of legal and non-legal areas including privacy law, legislative and bylaw drafting, policy development, human rights law and, occasionally, employment law. A background with a broad range of experience in legal matters would be an asset.

The starting date for the position is flexible, but the College would prefer a starting date no later than the end of May, 2019.
