



AMENDMENTS TO THE *CODE OF PROFESSIONAL CONDUCT* (March 2018):

At February 2018 Convocation, the Benchers approved amendments to the *Code*. Amendments are listed at the end of each Chapter.

The amendments are highlighted below.

3.3-3A Permitted Disclosure – amended to split the section into 2 parts and re-add *Mandatory Disclosure* as 3.3-3A and *Permitted Disclosure* as 3.3-3B, to clearly mark the difference between the standards of disclosure.

- The re-addition of the Mandatory Disclosure section as 3.3-3A returns the section to its original standard of mandatory disclosure, along with its commentary from the Permitted Disclosure section. The exception is the addition of “Mandatory Disclosure” to the Heading to clearly mark the difference between the standards of disclosure between 3.3-3A and 3.3-3B.
- Section 3.3-3A, on Permitted Disclosure – renumbered 3.3-3B to reflect Model Code numbering conventions and the addition of 3.3-3A, remove item (f), and remove the Commentary related to Mandatory Disclosure.
