NOTICE OF INTERIM SUSPENSION


TAKE NOTICE THAT NATHAN PHILLIPS of Regina, Saskatchewan has been placed on interim suspension pursuant to section 45 of *The Legal Profession Act, 1990* and as of April 2, 2019 is not entitled to practice law until further notice.

The Law Society of Saskatchewan has reasonable grounds to believe that NATHAN PHILLIPS may be guilty of conduct unbecoming a lawyer in that it appears that he has, and continues to, employ frivolous and vexatious tactics in his legal practice in a manner that is inimical to the best interests of the public and harmful to the standing of the legal profession.

Further or in the alternative, the Law Society has reasonable grounds to believe that NATHAN PHILLIPS lacks competency.

The Law Society of Saskatchewan Conduct Investigation Committee has determined that further investigation is required in connection with the conduct of NATHAN PHILLIPS and that to allow him to continue to practice during the investigation would present an immediate risk to the public.
