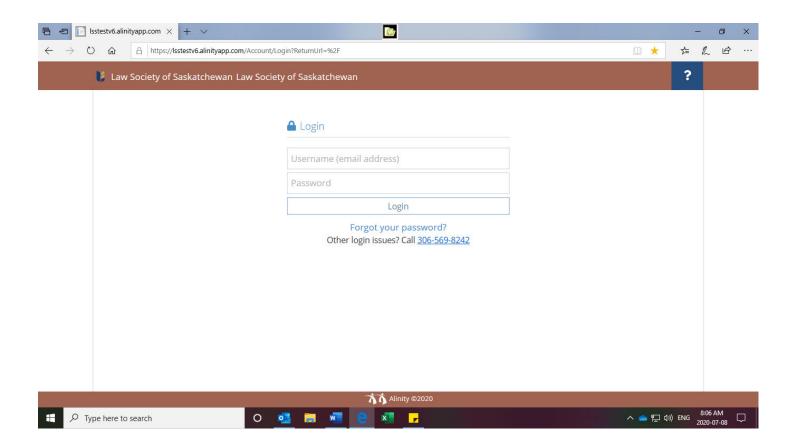
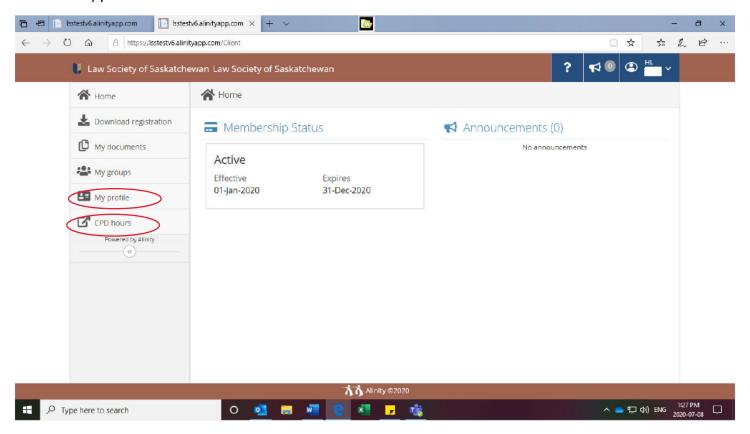


Clicking on the Members Profile link will take you to a log in screen where you will need to enter in your login credentials. Your login credentials are your email address and password that you currently have with the Law Society.

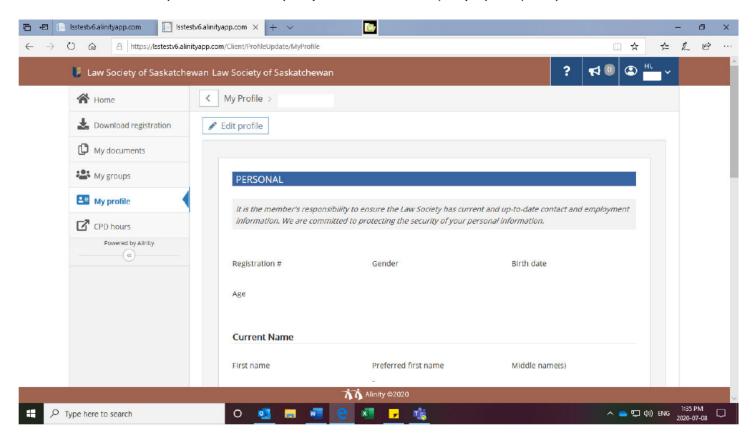

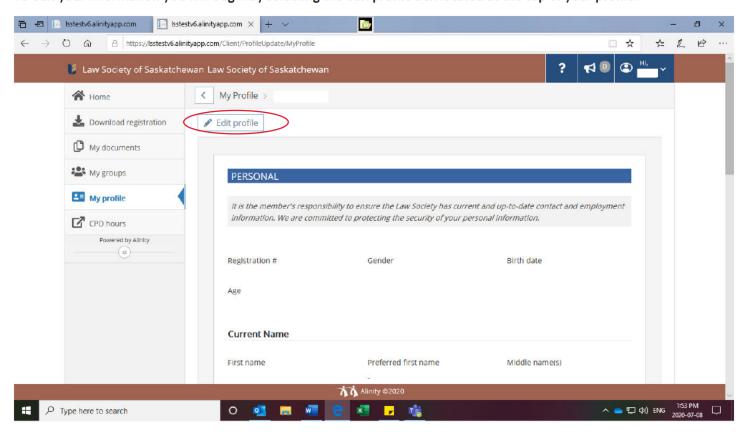
After logging in you will be brought to an updated home screen. On this screen you will see important tabs such as CPD hours and My profile.



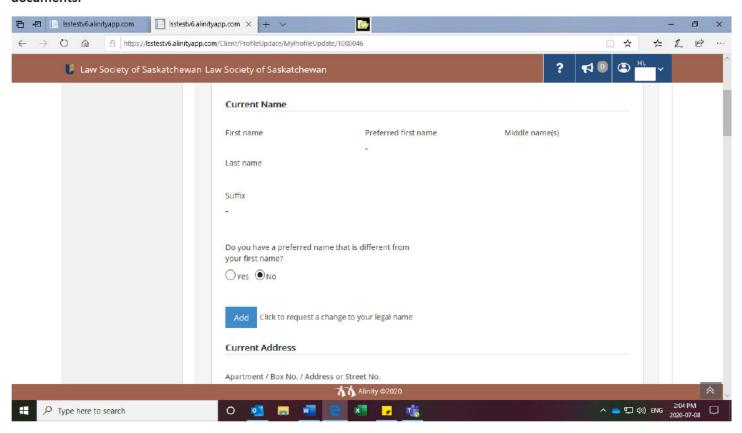
Selecting the My profile tab gives you access to the current information you have registered with the Law Society. This screen is also the screen you will use to edit your personal information, employment, and your areas of law.



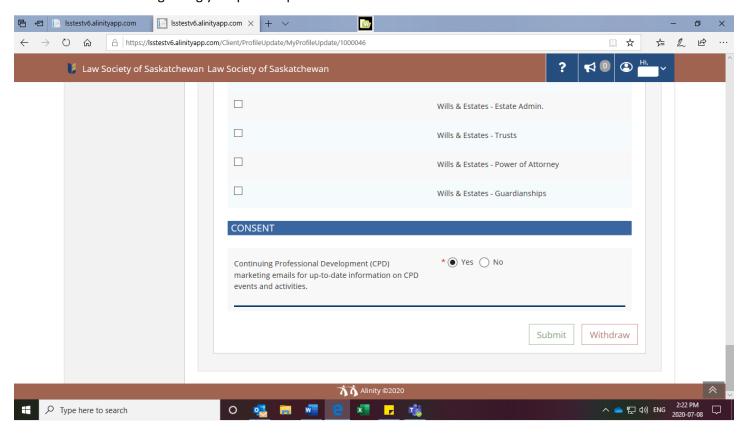
To edit your information you will begin by selecting the edit profile box located at the top of your profile.



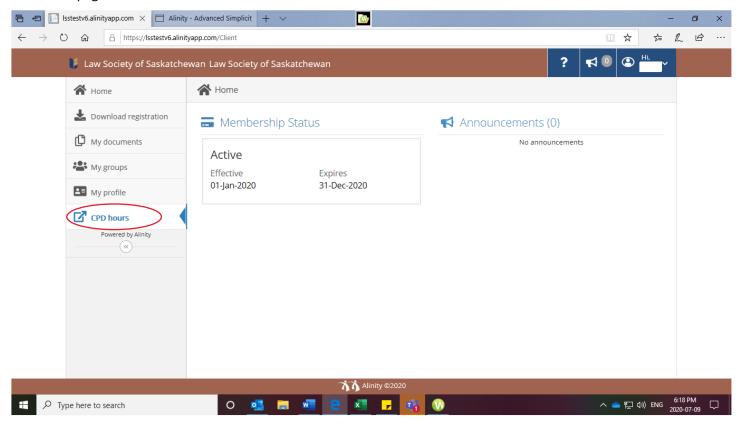
Each section will have blue add buttons where you will update/change the information as well as upload any required documents.



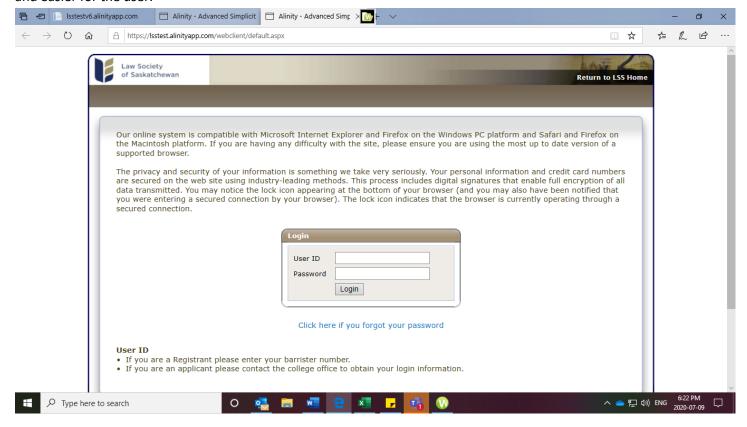
Once you finish any changes/updates to your profile select submit, which is located at the bottom of the page. You will then receive an email regarding your profile update.



To record your CPD hours you will need to enter the CPD portal by first clicking on the CPD hours tab located on the left side of the page.



Once you enter the CPD hours screen you will see a familiar log in page where you will have to enter your Barrister Number and password. Please note, this is temporary and will be updated in the near future to make this step quicker and easier for the user.



Once you log into this portal you will complete recording your CPD hours in the same way you have been in the past.
