## PRACTICE CONDITIONS SUMMARY

On February 25, 2020, in response to a variety of issues of concern to the Law Society of Saskatchewan, the Member provided undertakings to the Law Society of Saskatchewan, which remain in effect, wherein the Member agreed to practice under the supervision of Nicholas Stooshinoff, Q.C.;

Continued concerns on the part of the Law Society of Saskatchewan prompted the Conduct Investigation Committee to issue to the Member a Notice of Intention to Interim Suspended dated September 17, 2020;

The Member has agreed to provide the following undertakings to the Law Society of Saskatchewan in lieu of an interim suspension and in order to have consideration of the Member's interim suspension placed into abeyance;

The Member, a Lawyer of Saskatoon, Saskatchewan, hereby undertakes as follows:

- 1. The Member will not, from the date of these undertakings, take on any new clients;
- 2. The Member will not from the date of these undertakings take on any new matters from an existing client;
- 3. The Member will wind down his legal practice and entirely cease the practice of law on or before December 31, 2020.

## Withdrawal of Undertaking

- 4. The Member provides these undertakings with the proviso that he will be entitled to withdraw them, and in the event he wishes to exercise that entitlement, the Member undertakes to provide 21 days' advance notice to the Law Society of Saskatchewan with appropriate supporting materials, in order to allow the Conduct Investigation Committee to reconvene and bring the matter of his interim suspension out of abeyance;
- 5. The Member will continue to be bound by these undertakings until the process for withdrawal has been completed.

## **Breach of Undertakings**

- 6. The Member understands that if he breaches any of the foregoing undertakings, he may be subject to discipline by the Society;
- 7. The Member understands that if he breaches any of the foregoing undertakings, he may be suspended by the Conduct Investigation Committee without notice.
