1. Charged or accepted a fee or disbursement that was not:


- in relation to his representation of Cowessess First Nation No. 73.

- (a) his client;  
(b) the Court; and/or  
(c) other members of the profession;

honourably and with integrity in relation to the application for fee assessment and the taxation of fees by Cowessess First Nation No. 73.

3. Failed to advise and encourage his client, Cowessess First Nation No. 73, to compromise or settle disputes on a reasonable basis and discourage the client from commencing or continuing useless legal proceedings in relation to the small claims matter involving G.A.
