PROTOCOL FORM OF ADDRESS AND PRONOUNS FOR COURT PARTICIPANTS

Provincial Court of Saskatchewan invites counsel and self-represented individuals to identify their preferred manner of address (for example, Mr, Ms, Mx, Counsel) and/or pronouns (for example, she/her, he/him, they/them).

Counsel and self-represented individuals may contact the Court Manager in writing in advance of the Court proceeding, advising of their preference.

Alternatively, counsel and self-represented individuals can advise the Court Clerk of their preferred pronouns and titles just prior to the proceeding. They may also advise of the preferred pronouns and titles of other individuals attending Court in relation to their proceeding (for example, witnesses) if they have knowledge of this.
