FORMAL COMPLAINT

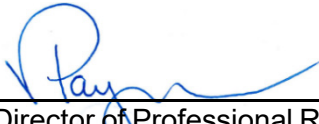
I, Valerie Payne of the City of Regina, in the Province of Saskatchewan, Director of Professional Responsibility for the Law Society of Saskatchewan, do hereby certify that Greg Walen, K.C., Hearing Administrator, of the Law Society of Saskatchewan, has appointed a Hearing Committee pursuant to Rule 1118 comprised of Leah Howie, as Chair along with Andrew Livingston and Shelby Hamm to hear and determine a Formal Complaint set out by the Conduct Investigation Committee pursuant to Rule 1116, against **KELLIE RAYE WUTTUNEE**, a lawyer and a Member of the Law Society of Saskatchewan, carrying on the practice of law at all of the relevant times in the Hamlet of Cando, in the Province of Saskatchewan, as follows:

THAT **KELLIE RAYE WUTTUNEE**, of the Hamlet of Cando, in the Province of Saskatchewan, is guilty of conduct unbecoming a lawyer in that she:

1. Did fail in her duty to exercise prudent care over, and maintain the safety and confidentiality of, client documents in her possession in that, on or around June 22, 2025, she abandoned approximately 200 client files with documents containing confidential information at a publicly accessible disposal site, without taking adequate precautions to ensure confidential documents were properly destroyed prior to disposal;
2. Did apply, or did cause the application of, signatures purporting to be those of her clients on multiple documents, including the Payment of Compensation by Cheque in Trust and Statement in Support of Motion for Fee Approval documents on multiple client files (purportedly) opened on or around February 16 and 17, 2023;
3. Did, across numerous files, purport to witness the signatures of her clients applied to the Payment of Compensation by Cheque in Trust document when the client signature was not applied by her clients;

4. Did mislead the Law Society by advising that she had personally destroyed confidential documents and files that were not in fact destroyed.
5. Did breach her duties of honesty and integrity.
