### Registration Fee: \$1500 +\$75 GST (\$1575.00)

Register early! Enrollment is limited to 32 lawyers and will be on a first come, first served basis. However, preference will be given to lawyers with 15 years or less experience at the Bar. The registration fee must accompany your registration. The registration deadline is **Thursday, September 18, 2025**. We will confirm your registration. In the event the maximum enrollment is reached, a waiting list will be kept in case there are cancellations. We will notify you no later than October 20, 2025 if we are able to add you to the Workshop list. After this date, we will return your registration fee to you.
