Formal Complaint

I, VALERIE PAYNE of the City of Regina, in the Province of Saskatchewan, Director of Professional Responsibility Counsel for the Law Society of Saskatchewan, do hereby certify that Greg Walen, Q.C., Hearing Administrator, of the Law Society of Saskatchewan, has appointed a Hearing Committee pursuant to Rule 1118 comprised of James Morrison, K.C., as Chair along with Maya Scott and Debra Parker-Loewen to hear and determine a Formal Complaint set out by the Conduct Investigation Committee pursuant to Rule 1116, against Delbert Dynna, a lawyer and a member of the Law Society of Saskatchewan, carrying on the practice of law at all of the relevant times in the City of Prince Albert, in the Province of Saskatchewan, as follows:

THAT DEBERT DYNNA, of the City of Prince Albert, in the Province of Saskatchewan, is guilty of conduct unbecoming a lawyer in that he:

1. failed, and/or refused, to honour a trust condition by which he was bound.
