



TO: THE MEMBERS OF THE LAW SOCIETY OF SASKATCHEWAN

TAKE NOTICE THAT AMMAD ANWAR of Unity, Saskatchewan has been placed on interim suspension pursuant to section 45 of *The Legal Profession Act, 1990* and Law Society of Saskatchewan Rules 1121 and 1122, and as of February 4, 2025, is not entitled to practice law until further notice.

The Law Society of Saskatchewan has reasonable grounds to believe that AMMAD ANWAR has acted in breach of the trust accounting rules of the Law Society of Saskatchewan.

Further, the Law Society of Saskatchewan has reasonable grounds to believe that AMMAD ANWAR has facilitated transactions that are fraudulent conveyances, or, contrary to anti-money laundering rules and regulations.

The Law Society of Saskatchewan Conduct Investigation Committee has determined that further investigation is required in connection with the conduct of AMMAD ANWAR and that to allow him to continue to practice during the investigation would present an immediate risk to the public.
