<b>Practice Directive 2 – Wire Transfer Procedures via Online Wire Payments Service</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- This Practice Directive has been <i>repealed</i> in its entirety. Amendments to Rule 1514, Procedure for Withdrawing Funds from a Pooled Trust Account, were approved at June 2023 Convocation, which addressed the issue that necessitated Practice Directive 2.</li> </ul>	139 - 144	139 - 142
