Saskatchewan's diverse population relies on access to legal information

to meaningfully access justice. Legal information is general information about the law and legal procedures. It is

distinct from legal advice as it does not interpret information for specific circumstances. Legal information can help people learn about their legal problems, the law, ways of resolving problems through the legal system, and their legal rights and responsibilities.

The 2022 Final Report of the Legal Data Scan and Needs Assessment in Saskatchewan

is a top five legal need in the province.

People require access to general information about their legal problems and the justice system, as well as

how to go about addressing the problem. A large proportion of respondents from community-based organizations (60%) and lawyers (46%) agreed that people faced with a justice-related problem are only sometimes able to obtain effective legal information.
