



AMENDMENTS TO THE *CODE OF PROFESSIONAL CONDUCT* (October 1, 2025):

At June 2024 Convocation, the Benchers approved amendments to the *Code*. Amendments are listed at the end of each Chapter.

The amendments are highlighted below.

At June Convocation, amendments to the *Code of Professional Conduct* were approved by the Benchers, effective October 1, 2025, pertaining to, the title, Chapter 1 – Interpretation and Definitions, 3.1 – Competence, 4.3 – Advertising Nature of Practice and 7.2 – Responsibility to Lawyers and Others. The amendments are required to formalize the limited licensing of legal professionals effective October 1, 2025, in accordance with amendments to *The Legal Profession Act, 1990*. These amendments recognize limited licensees as regulated members of the Law Society of Saskatchewan entitled to engage in the limited practice of law.

The title has been updated from the “*Code of Professional Conduct*” to the “*Code of Professional Conduct for Lawyers*” to distinguish from the *Code of Professional Conduct for Limited Licensees*

1.1 Definitions

1.1-1 – definition for “members” added to include lawyers and limited licensees

3.1 Competence

3.1-2 – Competence – Commentary [11] pertaining to a multi-discipline practice is amended to remove language for consistency with the *Code of Professional Conduct for Limited Licensees*.

4.3 Advertising Nature of Practice

4.3-1 – amended to clarify restriction applies to advertising a specialization in a “legal” field.

7.2 Responsibility to Lawyers and Others

7.2-1 -Courtesy and Good Faith - Commentary [5] added to recognize limited licensees as part of the legal profession in Saskatchewan.
