## **TO: THE MEMBERS OF THE LAW SOCIETY OF SASKATCHEWAN**

**TAKE NOTICE THAT KELLIE RAYE WUTTUNEE** of Cando/Saskatoon, Saskatchewan has been placed on interim suspension pursuant to section 45 of *The Legal Profession Act, 1990* and Law Society of Saskatchewan Rule 1121, and as of June 29, 2026, is not entitled to practice law until further notice.

The Law Society of Saskatchewan has reasonable grounds to believe that KELLIE RAYE WUTTUNEE has:

- failed to comply with court ordered processes set out by the Federal Court of Canada and has misled the Federal Court of Canada in connection with applications she made for payment of her fees pursuant to the Federal Indian Day School litigation process.
- on numerous occasions, disregarded the trust accounting rules of the Law Society of Saskatchewan.
- misappropriated funds held in trust on behalf of her clients.
- abandoned numerous client files in a public location knowing that the files contained sensitive personal and health information related to her clients.
- applied, or did cause the application of, signatures purporting to be those of her clients on multiple documents.
- on numerous occasions, purported to witness signatures of her clients when those signatures were not applied by her clients.
- intentionally misled the Law Society of Saskatchewan.

The Law Society of Saskatchewan Conduct Investigation Committee has determined that, while formal allegations in relation to the above have yet to be proven, to allow KELLIE RAYE WUTTUNEE to continue to practice while the allegations are pending would present an immediate risk to the public.
