#### ***Document Summary***

Bill 163, an *Act to Amend The Legal Profession Act, 1990*, was introduced in the Saskatchewan Legislature on December 3, 2018, and *The Legal Profession Amendment Act, 2019* received Royal Assent on May 15, 2019. On October 1, 2025, the Government of Saskatchewan proclaimed into force the outstanding sections of Bill 163, to formalize the limited licensing of legal professionals in Saskatchewan. Amendments to the *Law Society of Saskatchewan Rules* were necessitated by these changes.

This redraft of the *Law Society of Saskatchewan Rules* aligns with the statutory changes to include limited licensees as recognized regulated members of the Law Society of Saskatchewan entitled to engage in the limited practice of law.

The October 1, 2025 version posted to the Law Society's website is now the most current version. If you maintain a hard copy in your office, please be sure to remove the old version in its entirety and replace it with the new version.
